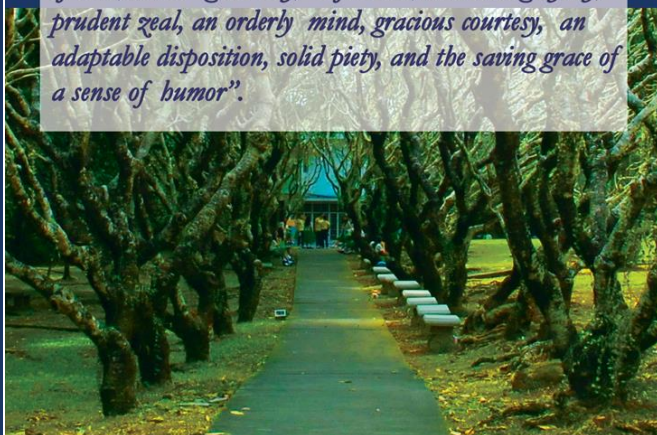

General Guidelines for Admission

1. New students are accepted in Grades 9,10 and 11 only.
2. Students in Grade 8, 9, or 10 or their equivalent levels in the current school year are qualified to apply for admission.
3. Applicants from schools overseas must submit the following additional requirements:
 - a. Original and one clear photocopy of passport
 - b. Documents for the issuance of Special Study Permit (SSP)
 - c. Transcript of Records
 - d. Curriculum profile/description of current school written in English
 - e. Certificate of Recognition as a Filipino if with dual citizenship

Application Procedure

- STEP 1** Secure the following from the BEU Admissions Office (all forms may be downloaded from www.mc.edu.ph/Admissions/HighSchoolAdmissions)
- a. Application Slip
 - b. Personal Data Form
 - c. Recommendation Forms
 - d. Student Health Record Form

For MC Middle School applicants, the preparation and submission of item c will be facilitated by the BEU Registrar's Office.

- STEP 2** Present and submit the accomplished forms/slip to the BEU Admissions Office.

- STEP 3** Pay the non-refundable Application and Testing Fee of Php 500.00 to the Cashier.

- STEP 4** Submit the following requirements:
- a. Certified True Copy of Previous and Current Report Cards
 - b. Original copy of National Statistics Office (NSO) Birth Certificate
 - c. Original and clear photocopy of Baptismal Certificate



- d. 3 pcs. of 2"x 2" recent, identical and colored ID pictures with applicant's name written on the reverse side
- e. MCHS Waiver Form for non-Catholics signed by parents or guardian

For MC Middle School applicants, the preparation and submission of items a-c will be facilitated by the BEU Registrar's Office.

STEP 5 Upon submission of all the requirements, secure a copy of Test Permit that indicates the testing schedule.

STEP 6 Take the placement test on the scheduled date.

Scholarships

Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) Scholarship

This is given to highly selected students in Grade 9 and 11 who belong to the top 3% of successful examinees in terms of proficiency scores in science and mathematics. Grade 9 recipients shall enjoy a four-year scholarship while Grade 11 recipients shall enjoy a two-year full scholarship.

Academic Merit Scholarship

This is given to highly selected students certified by their Principals/School Heads as belonging to the top 5 of a total student batch population of at least 70 students. They shall be entitled to tuition fee discounts in their first year of schooling provided that they pass the admissions test on a clean slate status and scholarship interview.



Application and Testing Period

1. Application for admission begins on September
2. Placement examinations shall be held on the following days:
 - 2nd Saturday of October - for MCMS students only
 - 1st Saturday of December
 - 1st Saturday of February

Placement Test Guidelines

1. The set of tests shall determine proficiency in various learning areas.
2. Be at the designated testing site at least 30 minutes before the test. (Latecomers will not be allowed to enter the Testing Room once the examination has started.)
3. Present the Test Permit to the proctor.
4. Bring the following:
 - Sharpened Mongol pencils #2 and eraser
 - Valid identification card with picture
 - Snacks and drink
5. Get the results of the examination at the BEU Registrar's Office on the date announced by proctor.

Only complete application requirements will be accepted by the BEU Registrar's office for processing.
