- NSO Birth Certificate, original and photocopy
- Form 138 - Report Card (preferably, the final average grade is 80%+)
- Form 137 – Transcript of Records
- Character Reference from last school attended / sponsoring organization or Barangay/ Police Clearance
- ITR or Certification with salary from employer (if applicant is employed) / ITR or Certification with salary of parents (if applicant is not employed)
- Photocopy of Marriage Contract (if married)
- Chest x-ray (film / medical certificate) – to be submitted during enrollment
- Three (3) Passport size ID picture (white background with name)
