

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

The Department of Environment offers three certificate programs:

Certificate in Environmental Education (EE)
Certificate in Environmental Management (EM)
Certificate in Environmental Studies (ES)

ACADEMIC COURSE REQUIREMENTS

Twelve units of foundation courses are required:

ES 201.1	Environmental Science	3
ES 207	Technology and the Environment	3
ES 208	Culture and the Environment	3
ES 220	Ecology	3

MAJOR COURSES ARE AS FOLLOWS:

For EE: ES 232	Environmental Education	3
For ES: ES 211	Environmental Impact Assessment	3
For EM: ES 233	Environmental Management	3

A three-unit elective is required for each certificate program. Students may choose from any of the Graduate Program Courses. The choice of the course would depend on the student's training needs.

ADMISSION TO THE CERTIFICATE PROGRAM

Students entering these programs should pass the Graduate Level Entrance Test administered by the Center for Educational Measurement.

Other requirements before a certificate is granted:

A mini-paper that integrates the student's learning.

A weighted grade average of B.
